BRILLIANT NEW PROGRAMME FOR 2013-14

TUESDAY 10 SEPTEMBER followed by a talk by John Coppinger called 'Sculpture for Science & Film'

John Coppinger is a sculptor with over forty years experience of re-constructing dinosaurs for museums and creating creatures for films. His interest in both art and science led to a job at London's Natural History Museum and then thirty years of special effects work in the British Film Industry. He was involved in the early days of Animatronics; a field which revo-



lutionised the way animals and alien creatures are portrayed on film.

Jackie is greatly influenced by the graphic quality of Japanese art, and the light of her adopted country, France. Her first love is pure watercolour, but she is equally at home with pen and ink as well as pastels and fine art printmaking. Vermeer's paintings. My paintings are figurative, metamorphic representation. The main key to my art is the relationship between light and shadow. Colours are also a very important aspect of my work so I use them sparingly with respect and with the knowledge of the relativism.
