'LANDSCAPE AND MEANING

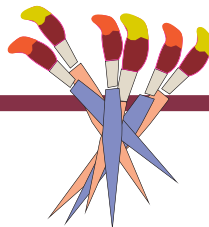

During this workshop I intend to show how to "make" a picture using just 1 flower or 1 stem of flowers by starting with loose washes and building up colour and shape. Much emphasis will be placed on the use of colour, tone and negative shape, as well as working wet-in-wet with mixed washes. Painters will need to bring a flower (photographs will not do), their watercolour paints and a piece of watercolour paper taped on to a board.
