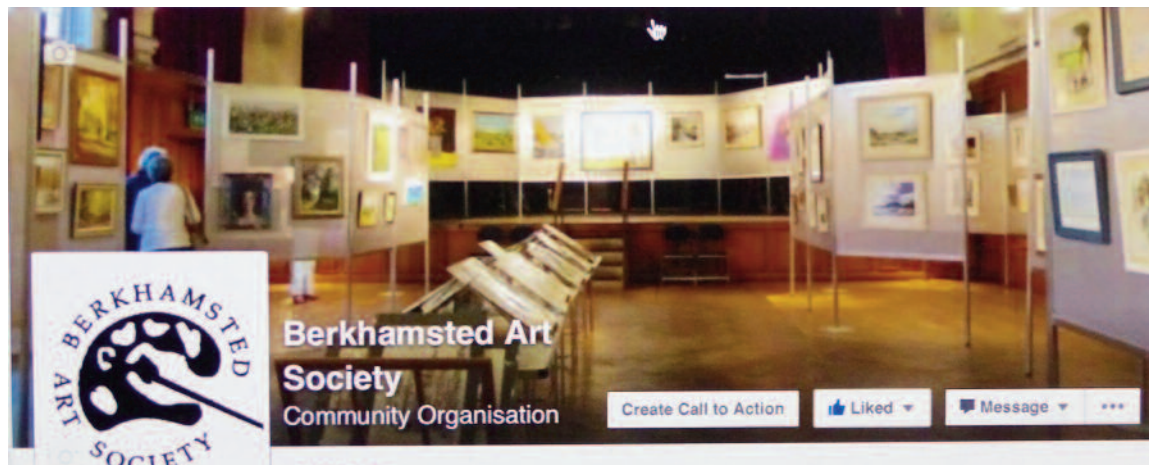
Please Note that we have increased the number of entries members can submit from 4 to 5

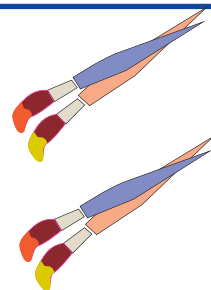
